WHEREAS, during the emergency meeting of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) held on 12 March, 2020, its Members have discussed and agreed to adopt the alternative method of Negotiated Procurement in emergency cases and circumstances;

WHEREAS, the PGOM finds it necessary to adopt the alternative method of Negotiated Procurement (Emergency Cases) modality in order to respond in the most timely manner to the deadly threat of COVID-19, protect its people from the possible entry and spread of this deadly virus and re-enforce its capability to effectively and efficiently respond to the worst-case scenario during these dire circumstances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to adopt the alternative method of Negotiated Procurement (Emergency Cases) modality for the procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting services amidst the threat of COVID-19:

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the conditions and requirements set forth under Annex "H" (V)(D)(2) of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184 and GPPB Resolution No. 03-2020, copies attached, be complied with for procurement falling under emergency cases and circumstances;

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Office of the Provincial Governor, for his favorable consideration and approval.
