### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 08 Series of 2022

#### AN EXECUTIVE ORDER GRANTING MONETARY INCENTIVES TO BARANGAY TANODS IN THE PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

**WHEREAS**, during the Provincial Governor's Inaugural Address, a commitment to provide additional monetary incentives to all *Barangay Tanods* in the province was made as one of the priority projects of the administration.

**WHEREAS**, the fund allocation for the grant of incentives was included in Appropriation Ordinance No. 741-2020, Annual Investment Program (AIP) code 1011-2 in the amount of Four Million Pesos (PhP4,000,000.00) under "Strengthening of Partnerships/Linkages, Government Councils, Leagues and other Local Bodies."

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Appropriation Ordinance No. 753-2021, there is sufficient funding in the amount of Four Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP4,200,000.00) under the Governor's Office as sufficient authority for the disbursement of funds.

**WHEREAS**, on 10 March 2022, the Provincial Finance Committee informed the Provincial Governor that the aforementioned funds were booked as a Continuing Appropriation for Calendar Year 2022, and since the same were deemed approved budgets, the Local Chief Executive hereby lays down the provisions in the disbursement of cash incentives of the *Barangay Tanods*.

**WHEREAS**, it is proper to recognize the inviolable efforts and roles of *Barangay Tanods* in keeping the peace and order during the time of pandemic and as members of the *Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHERT)* through one-time monetary incentive.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, HUMERLITO A. DOLOR, MPA, PH.D.** by virtue of the power vested in me as Provincial Governor by Section 465 (b) (2) (iii), Article One, Chapter 3, Title IV, Book III of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, do hereby promulgate this Executive Order, as follows:

**SECTION 1. Grant of Monetary Incentives to Barangay Tanods.** *Barangay Tanods* who were duly appointed shall be given the Two Thousand Pesos (PhP2,000.00) monetary incentive.

**SECTION 2. Reportorial Requirements.** The Governor's Office, upon proper validation, will submit to the Office of the Provincial Accountant (OPA) a payroll of qualified *Barangay Tanods* together with any of the following: a) Certifications of Appointment issued by the concerned Punong Barangays; or b) List of appointed *Barangay Tanods* issued by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG).

Within ten (10) working days from the disbursement of abovementioned monetary grant, the Governor's Office will submit to the OPA the following documents:

- a. Payrolls duly signed by qualified of *Barangay Tanods*;
- b. Certifications of Appointment issued by concerned Punong Barangay; and
- c. List of appointed *Barangay Tanods* issued by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG)

**SECTION 3. Separability Clause.** If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid for any reason, the parts not affected shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4. Repealing Clause.** All other issuances inconsistent with this Executive Order are deemed repealed and/or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 5. Effectivity.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
