EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 35 Series of 2022

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER REORGANIZING THE ENHANCED COMPREHENSIVE LOCAL INTEGRATION PROGRAM (E-CLIP) COMMITTEE OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ORIENTAL MINDORO, DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution declares that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment of all people;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates the Local Government Units (LGUs) to provide the social welfare services which include programs and projects for all, even those who decide to return to mainstream society, the rebel returnees;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 70, Series of 2018 issued by the Office of the President of the Philippines directs the development of the inter-agency convergence in the implementation of the national peace framework in conflict-affected and vulnerable communities, and interventions to facilitate local peace engagements;

WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 10, Series of 2018 of the Office of the President is committed in attaining a just, comprehensive and lasting peace under the rule of law, which is the basic foundation for economic development and national prosperity;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the Department of National Defense (DND) issued Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2021-01 dated September 22, 2021 Re: **"IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES ON THE PROVISION OF DILG-ADMINISTERED PACKAGE OF ASSISTANCE FOR FORMER REBELS (FRs) AND FORMER VIOLENT EXTREMISTS (FVEs) UNDER THE ENHANCED COMPREHENSIVE LOCAL INTEGRATION PROGRAM (E-CLIP)"** to govern the implementation of the DILG-administered Package of Assistance under E-CLIP;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Governor issued an Executive Order No. 215 series of 2019, dated 07 October 2019 entitled Reorganizing and Renaming the Comprehensive Local Integration Program (CLIP) Committee of the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro to Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program (E-CLIP) Committee, Redefining its Functions, and for other purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, I, HUMERLITO A. DOLOR, MPA, Ph.D., Provincial Governor of the Province of Oriental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me under Section 465 (b) (2)(ii), Article One, Chapter 3, Book III of Republic Act No. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991, do promulgate this Executive Order as follows:

SECTION 1. Reorganization of the Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program (E-CLIP). The Enhanced Comprehensive Local Integration Program (E-CLIP) Committee of the Province of Oriental Mindoro is hereby reorganized to be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. Duties and Functions. The E-CLIP Committee shall perform the following duties and duties:

- a. Develop an E-CLIP Committee Implementation Plan (ECCIP);
- b. Ensure the convergence effort in the delivery of the delivery of the identified services of the program;
- c. Ensure proper documentation and referral of the needs of the Former Rebels (FRs) and Former Violent Extremists (FVEs) to appropriate agencies and partner institutions including getting profile of the FRs and FVEs;
- d. Facilitate the profiling of the Former Rebels (FRs) and Former Violent Extremists (FVEs) through the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO);
- e. Assist the Former Rebels (FRs) and Former Violent Extremists (FVEs) in completing the E-CLIP Enrolment form;
- f. Assists the FR, with the lead of the PSWDO, in the preparation of his/her Former Rebel Reintegration Plan (FRRP) AND Business Plan;
- g. Resolve issues and concerns affecting the implementation of the E-CLIP;
- h. Provide updates to the Provincial Peace and Order Council (PPOC) during its meeting regarding the progress of the E-CLIP; and
- i. Coordinate and monitor the E-CLIP implementation in the Province.

SECTION 3. E-CLIP Focal Person. For the purpose of ensuring effective E-CLIP program implementation in the province, the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Officer (PSWDO) is designated as the focal person of E-CLIP.

SECTION 4. Functions of E-CLIP Focal Person. The designated E-CLIP Focal Person shall exercise the following functions:

- a. Facilitate information sharing to the Provincial E-CLIP Committee from outside agencies and vice-versa;
- b. Serve as communication link between the Provincial E-CLIP Committee and outside government entities relative to E-CLIP Committee and outside government entities relative to E-CLIP;

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- c. Coordinate preparation and submission of E-CLIP required reports, plans and other related program documents and ensure that the deadline of submission is met; and
- d. Collaborate with the DILG Regional and Provincial Field Office on E-CLIP updates for dissemination to the Provincial E-CLIP Committee.

SECTION 5. Secretariat. The Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) shall serve as Secretariat to the E-CLIP Committee. It shall exercise the following duties and functions:

- a. Prepare plans and programs for the consideration of the E-CLIP Committee;
- b. Monitor the implementation of approved policies, plans, and programs under the E-CLIP;
- c. Ensure meetings are effectively and documented;
- d. Undertake relevant liaising and coordination activities with appropriate agencies of the government; and
- e. Performs such other functions as may be directed by the E-CLIP Committee.

SECTION 6. Funding. The funding for the implementation of the programs and activities of the E-CLIP shall be charged against the general fund of the Office of the Provincial Governor.

SECTION 7. Repealing Clause. All provincial executive orders, rules, regulations, and other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
