EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 41 Series of 2022

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER REORGANIZING THE PROVINCIAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD (PSWMB), PRESCRIBING ITS FUNCTIONS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, prescribes the creation of a Solid Waste Management Board at the provincial, city, and municipal levels that will spearhead the implementation of the Act.

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 08, Series of 2005 was issued by the Provincial Governor in conformity with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9003 otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 which prescribes the creation of a Solid Waste Management Board at the provincial, city, and municipal levels.

WHEREAS, on 16 July 2019, Executive Order No. 172-A series of 2019 entitled "*An Executive Order Reorganizing the Provincial Solid Waste Management Board (PSWMB), prescribing its functions and for other purposes*" was issued.

WHEREAS, there is a need to reorganize the Provincial Solid Waste Management Board since there are substantial changes in its composition by reason of election, appointment, transfer, promotion, or retirement.

NOW THEREFORE, I, HUMERLITO A. DOLOR, MPA, PH.D., by virtue of the power vested in me as Provincial Governor by Section 465 (b) (2) (iii), Article One, Chapter 3, Title IV, Book III of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, do hereby promulgate this Executive Order, as follows:

SECTION 1. Reorganizing the Provincial Solid Waste Management Board (PSWMB). The Provincial Solid Waste Management Board for the Province of Oriental Mindoro is hereby reorganized to be composed of the following:

SECTION 3. Duties and Functions. The Provincial Solid Waste Management Board shall have the following duties and functions:

1. Develop a provincial solid waste management plan from the submitted solid waste management plans of the respective city and municipal solid waste management boards. It shall review and integrate the submitted plans of all its component cities and municipalities and ensure that the various plan complement each other, and have the requisite components. The Provincial Solid Waste Management Plan (PSWMP) shall be submitted to the National Solid Waste Management Commission for approval;
2. Ensure that the Provincial Solid Waste Management Plan reflects the general program of action and initiatives of the provincial government and implementing a solid waste management program that would support the various initiatives of its component cities and municipalities;
3. Provide the necessary logistical and operational support to its component cities and municipalities in consonance with the subsection (f) of Sec.17 of the Local Government Code;
4. Recommend measures and safeguards against pollution and for the preservation of the natural ecosystem;
5. Recommend measures to generate resource, funding and implementation of project and activities as specified in the duly approved solid waste management plans;
6. Identify areas within its jurisdiction which have common solid waste management problems and are appropriate units are planning local solid waste management services in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9003;
7. Coordinate the efforts of the component cities and municipalities in the implementation of the Provincial Solid Waste Management Plan;
8. Develop an appropriate incentive scheme as an integral component of the Provincial Solid Waste Management Plan;
9. Convene joint meetings of the provincial, city and municipal solid waste management boards at least every quarter for purposes of integrating, synchronizing, monitoring and evaluating the development and implementation of its provincial solid waste management plan;
10. Represent any of its component city or municipality in coordinating its resource and operational requirements with agencies of the national government;
11. Oversee the implementation of the Provincial Solid Waste Management Plan;
12. Review every two (2) years or as the need arises the Provincial Solid Waste Management Plan for purposes of ensuring its sustainability, viability, effectiveness and relevance in relation to local and international development in the field of solid waste management; and

13. Allow for the clustering of LGUs for the solution of common solid waste management problems.

SECTION 4. Secretariat. The PG-ENRO shall provide secretariat services to the Board. It shall have the following functions:

1. Assist the PSWMB in convening meetings;
2. Prepare all documents that are to be tabled for deliberation by the Board;
3. Record and document all the proceedings of the PSWMB meetings;
4. Index and keep all records used and referenced by the Board; and
5. Perform other functions as may deemed necessary by the Board.

SECTION 5. Funding. The funds needed to carry out the functions of the PSWMB and its activities shall be chargeable against the funds of the Office of the Governor.

SECTION 6. Repealing Clause. All prior issuances inconsistent with this Executive Order shall be repealed and/or superseded by this Order.

SECTION 7. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
