EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 48 Series of 2022

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER INSTITUTIONALIZING THE OPERATION OF THE CLIMATE VULNERABILITY AND RISK INFORMATION SYSTEM (CVRIS), PROVIDING FOR ITS CLIMATE RISK ADAPTATION PLANNING, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9729 or the “*Climate Change Act*” and its Implementing Rules and Regulations enjoins the participation of national and local governments, businesses, non-government organizations, local communities, and the public to prevent and reduce the adverse impacts of climate change and, at the same time, maximize the benefits of climate change.

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro (PGOM) aims to formulate and implement local climate change action plans, which should ideally provide the blueprint to enhance the adaptive capacity of local communities to climate change impacts and disruptions;

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Understanding between PGOM and the Global Green Growth Institute (GGGI) was signed on 12 October 2020 to formalize a framework of cooperation and collaboration towards the implementation of mutually agreed technical activities covering climate-resilient agriculture value chain development and renewable energy promotion in the Province of Oriental Mindoro;

WHEREAS, the Climate Vulnerability and Risk Information System (CVRIS) was developed by GGGI under the project titled “*Climate Resilient and Inclusive Green Growth Project: Accelerating Implementation in the Agriculture Value Chain in Oriental Mindoro*” which is led and financed by GGGI and Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA), in cooperation with PGOM, Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), and Climate Change Commission (CCC).

WHEREAS, CVRIS will serve as a policy advisory tool for decision makers with data-driven monitoring and analytical information as well as a reference tool for the local communities to have greater access to relevant climate change information related to agriculture at the local level;

WHEREAS, there is a need to institutionalize the operations and management of the CVRIS in order to provide an analytical and informative data-driven platform to enhance adaptive capacity of the province through evidence-based policy planning.

NOW THEREFORE, I, HUMERLITO A. DOLOR, MPA, Ph. D., by virtue of the power vested in me as Provincial Governor by Section 465 (b) (2) (iii), Article One, Chapter 3, Title 4, Book III of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, do hereby promulgate this Executive Order, as follows:

SECTION 1. Creation of the Climate Vulnerability and Risk Information System Management Team (CVRIS-MT). The CVRIS Management Team is hereby created to be composed of the following groups:

SECTION 2. Functions of the Climate Vulnerability and Risk Information System Management Team. The groups of the CVRIS-MT shall have the following specific functions:

- A. The Chair Group of the CVRIS-MT shall take the lead role in requiring time-to-time operations for the CVRIS. They are also tasked with the following responsibilities:
- i. Spearhead the conduct the CVRIS tool's overall operation and management;
 - ii. Coordinate with focal personnel of PGOM's component LGUs for regular updates on the available data in their respective levels;
 - iii. Promote data collection for local farms and value chain facilities;
 - iv. Conduct regular update (based on the update frequency of the data) and management of the provincial level data;
 - v. Conduct regular verification and quality check of the updated data in the tool;
 - vi. Provide promotional support for the utilization of the tool by the people of Oriental Mindoro; and
 - vii. Provide support to the evidence-based provincial-level policy planning based on the tool.
- B. The Member Group shall perform the following duties and functions:
- i. Conduct regular update (based on the update frequency of the data) and management of the municipal level data;
 - ii. Conduct regular verification and quality check of the updated municipal-level data;
 - iii. Provide promotional support for the utilization of the tool by the municipality people;
 - iv. Provide coordinating support to PGOM for the CVRIS management and operation; and
 - v. Provide support to the evidence-based municipal-level policy planning based on the tool.
- C. Management Information System Group shall be responsible for overall technical management of the tool and server. Specifically, MISG shall perform the following functions:
- i. Maintenance of the backend for Google Cloud Platform (GCP); and

- ii. Server hosting management of the CVRIS which is embedded in the Provincial Government official website.

SECTION 3. Funding. The CVRIS-MT shall charge the expenses, technical support services, and other obligations necessary to perform their duties and functions against the funds of the PDRRMO.

SECTION 4. Repealing Clause. Any executive orders rules and regulations, and/or a part thereof that is contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Order is hereby revoked or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. Separability Clause. If any portion of this Executive Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts thereof which are not affected shall continue to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon approval hereof.
