### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14 Series of 2024

#### AN EXECUTIVE ORDER ESTABLISHING THE PROVINCIAL INTER-AGENCY COMMITTEE ON INDIGENOUS PEOPLE'S HEALTH, PROVIDING FOR ITS FUNCTIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

**WHEREAS**, on 2 December 2015, the Department of Health (DOH), National Commission on Indigenous People (NCIP), and Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 2015-01, directing the creation of Inter-Agency Committees on Indigenous Peoples' Health in the National, Regional, and Provincial Levels;

**WHEREAS**, the Inter-Agency Committees on Indigenous Peoples' Health is mandated to oversee the implementation of the DOH-NCIP-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 and to address issues that affect the provision of basic health care services for Indigenous Cultural Communities/Indigenous Peoples (ICCs/IPs);

**WHEREAS**, the DILG, in its Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 2018-65, issued on 10 May 2018, provided for the composition and functions of the Provincial Inter-Agency Committee on Indigenous Peoples' Health (PIAC-IPH);

**WHEREAS**, the creation of the Province's PIAC-IPH will operationalize the directive of DOH-NCIP-DILG JMC No. 2015-01 in Oriental Mindoro and improve access, knowledge, and delivery of basic health services to our local ICCs/IPs;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, HUMERLITO A. DOLOR, MPA, Ph. D.**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Local Government Code of 1991 and other pertinent laws of the Republic of the Philippines as the Provincial Governor of Oriental Mindoro, do hereby promulgate this Executive Order, as follows:

**SECTION 1. Provincial Inter-Agency Committee on Indigenous Peoples' Health (PIAC-IPH).** The Provincial Inter-Agency Committee on Indigenous Peoples' Health (PIAC-IPH) of the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro (PGOM) is hereby established to be composed of the following:

**SECTION 2. Request for Assistance.** Section 4 of DILG MC No. 2018-65 provides that, the PIAC-IPH may call upon or invite representatives from any department, bureau, office, agency, or instrumentality of the government, and request the local government units, the private sectors, and non-government organizations for assistance as the circumstances may require.

**SECTION 3. Functions of the Provincial Inter-Agency Committee on Indigenous Peoples' Health.** Pursuant to Section 4.2 of DILG MC No. 2018-65, the PIAC-IPH shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. Serve as the technical coordinating and monitoring arm in the implementation of JMC No. 2015-01 and its strategic plan at the local levels;
- b. Coordinate all technical concerns and requirements with various government agencies and non-government sectors, to facilitate and ensure effective implementation of JMC No. 2015-01 at the province, component city, and municipal levels, and assure complementation and synchronization of commitments and work deliverables;
- c. Provide technical assistance and capacity-building to local counterparts;
- d. Mobilize and link local stakeholders for functional networking and advocacy;
- e. Ensure the formulation and recommend approval and implementation of Ancestral Domain Sustainable Development and Protection Plan/Ancestral Domain Investment Plan for Health;
- f. Conduct periodic monitoring and evaluation in the implementation of ICCs/IPs health plans, programs, projects, at the provincial, component city, and municipal levels;
- g. Provide regular feedback and status reports on the progress of the implementation that will serve as the primary source of information of the Management Information System and Open Portal;
- h. Recommend policies to promote IP Health to LGUs, line agencies, and other concerned offices; and
- i. Perform other functions mandated by laws, rules, regulations, and other issuances.

**SECTION 4. Operational Tasks Provincial Inter-Agency Committee on Indigenous Peoples' Health.** The PIAC-IPH shall likewise undertake the following operational tasks enumerated under Section 4.2 of DILG MC No. 2018-65:

- a. Conduct regular meetings with documented minutes as well as related activities with proper proceedings;
- b. Submit regular status reports every semester to the Regional Inter-Agency Committee;
- c. Prepare Annual Provincial Inter-Agency Committee Plan to operationalize its roles and functions; and
- d. Ensure submission of the Provincial IP Health Plan and its integration to the Local Investment Plan for Health.

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**SECTION 5. Secretariat.** Personnel from the Provincial Health Office shall serve as the Secretariat of the PIAC-IPH. They shall render technical and administrative support to the PIAC-IPH and perform other task as may be required by the Committee in the performance of its functions.


**SECTION 6. Meetings.** The PIAC-IPH shall convene within a reasonable time upon the effectivity of this EO.

**SECTION 7. Repealing Clause.** All other executive orders, rules and regulations, issuances, or parts thereof inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby amended, repealed and/or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 8. Separability Clause.** If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional, the parts not affected shall remain valid and in full force.

**SECTION 9. Effectivity.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
