### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. <u>16-A</u> Series of 2024

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE STEERING COMMITTEE FOR THE REVIEW OF THE REVISED REVENUE CODE OF THE PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO, ITS TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) AND SECRETARIAT, DEFINING THEIR FUNCTIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Section 129 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that each local government unit (LGU) shall exercise its power to create its own sources of revenue and to levy taxes, fees, and charges, subject to limitations provided by law:

WHEREAS, on 15 December 2000, Provincial Ordinance No. 002-2000 also known as the "Revenue Code of the Province of Oriental Mindoro (2000)" was enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and approved on 31 January 2001.

WHEREAS, on 22 December 2011, Provincial Ordinance No. 001-2011, was promulgated to entitled the Revised Revenue Code of 2011, introduce relevant amendments and revenue rated.

WHEREAS, on 24 September 2020, Executive Order (EO) No. 51, Series of 2020 was issued to reorganize the Steering Committee tasked to spearhead the review of the Revised Revenue Code of 2011.

WHEREAS, considering that it has been nine (9) years since the last amendment of the Fe renue Code of Oriental Mindoro, it is now timely and appropriate that said Code be revised; there is a pressing need to revisit the Province's Revised Code of 2011 and to update its provisions and the prevailing tax, fees, and charges imposed therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HUMERLITO A. DOLOR, MPA, Ph.D., by the virtue of the powers vested in me as Provincial Governor of Oriental Mindoro by the Local Government Code of 1991 and other pertinent laws and issuances, do hereby promulgate this Executive Order, as follows:

Section 4. Functions of the TWG. The TWG of the Steering Committee shall exercise the following duties and functions:

- a. Ensure the availability of data needed for the revision of the Revised Revenue Code of 2011.
- Formulate the necessary amendments to the provisions of the Revised Revenue Code of 2011 pursuant to applicable laws and issuances.
- c. Request assistance of other concerned offices and/or agencies in the revision of Provincial Ordinance No. 021-2011.
- d. Update the fees and charges imposed by concerned PGOM Offices for the provision of services, issuance of documents, and other permits.
- e. Perform other tasks as may be necessary.

Section 5. Secretariat. The Provincial Treasury Office shall serve as the Secretariat of the Steering Committee. It shall perform the following functions.

- a. Compile all information, data, and materials related to the revision of the Revised Revenue Code of 2011.
- b. Arrange and coordinate meetings of the Steering Committee and its TWG;
- c. Record all proceedings and discussions that may arise from the meetings; and
- d. Perform such other tasks and functions as may be necessary.

**Section 6. Submission of Update.** The Steering Committee shall submit updates and accomplishments regarding the revision of Provincial Ordinance No. 021-2011 to the Previncial Governor within six (6) months from the approval of this Order.

Section 7. Meetings. The Steering Committee, as well as its TWG, shall meet as often as necessary in order to complete their duties and functions.

**Section 8. Funding.** Administrative expenses of the Steering Committee and its TWG shall be charged against the fund of the Governor's Office.

**Section 9. Repealing Clause.** Executive Order No. 51, series of 2020 is hereby repealed. All executive orders, rules, regulations, and other issuances including other parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

**Section** 19. Separability Clause. If any portion of this Executive Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts of the provision thereof which are not affected shall continue to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 11. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall be effect immediately upon its approval.
