EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 21 Series of 2024

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER REORGANIZING THE PROVINCIAL COMMITTEE ON ANTI-TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS AND ANTI-VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN (PCAT-VAWC)

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9208, otherwise known as the “*Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2003*,” as amended, directs the State to give highest priority to the enactment of measures and development programs that will promote human dignity, protect the people from violence and exploitation, eliminate trafficking in persons, and mitigate pressures for involuntary migration and servitude of persons.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9262, also known as the “*Anti-Violence Against Women and Their Children Act of 2004*,” provides that the State must safeguard the dignity of women and children while guaranteeing full respect of their human rights and in protecting them from violence and threats to their personal safety and security.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9710, otherwise known as “*Magna Carta of Women*,” seeks to eliminate discrimination through the recognition, protection, fulfillment and promotion of the rights of Filipino women;

WHEREAS, Joint Memorandum Circular 2010-01 of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), the Department of Social Welfare and Development and the Department of Justice directs the creation of the Local Committee on Anti-Trafficking and Violence Against Women and their Children in local government units (LGUs).

WHEREAS, there is a need to reorganize the composition of Oriental Mindoro’s Provincial Committee on Anti-Trafficking and Violence against Women and Children.

NOW THEREFORE, I, HUMERLITO A. DOLOR, MPA, Ph.D., by virtue of the powers vested in me as Provincial Governor of Oriental Mindoro by Republic Act. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, and other pertinent laws and issuances, do promulgate this Executive Order as follows:

SECTION 1. Reorganization of the Provincial Committee on Anti-Trafficking and Violence against Women and Children (PCAT-VAWC). The Provincial Committee on Anti-Trafficking and Violence against Women and Children is hereby reorganized as follows:

SECTION 2. Functions. The PCAT-VAWC shall perform the following duties and functions:

1. Undertake active information, education, and advocacy campaign activities against trafficking in persons and anti-VAWC;
2. Institute policies and programs to protect individuals from trafficking in persons and women and children from becoming victims of violence;
3. In aid of legislation, propose to the sanggunian the enactment of local ordinances and passage of resolutions aimed at establishing systems on surveillance, investigation, and rescue, and to ensure effective and efficient coordination with other national agencies regarding plans and activities against trafficking in persons and anti-VAWC;

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4. Undertake active information, education, and advocacy campaign activities against trafficking in persons and anti-VAWC;
5. Monitor and oversee the strict implementation of RA 9208, RA 9262, and other related laws for the protection of women and children, and of the inter-agency councils for Trafficking and VAWC national plans of action; and
6. Implement programs and activities as stated in the national plan of action against trafficking in persons and VAWC.

SECTION 3. The Provincial Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force of the PCAT-VAWC. The Provincial Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force of the PCAT-VAWC is hereby organized. It shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 4. Functions of the PCAT-VAWC Provincial Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force. The Provincial Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force of the PCAT-VAWC shall perform the following duties and functions:

- a. Assess the City/Municipal Committee on Anti Trafficking and Violence Against Women and their Children (C/MCAT-VAWC) based on the documents presented using LCAT-VAWC Form No. 1;
- b. Discuss with the concerned city/municipal mayors the outcome of the assessment and provide recommended actions to address issues concerning the functionality of C/MCAT-VAWC; and
- c. Consolidate and submit report using the LCAT-VAWC Form No. 3, in soft and hard copies, to the Regional Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force not later than April 15 of every year.

SECTION 5. Institutional Arrangements and Coordinating Procedures. The institutional arrangement and coordinating procedures for the PCAT-VAWC shall be guided by Section 4 of the DILG, DSWD, and DOJ Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2010-1, dated 18 October 2010.

SECTION 6. Secretariat. The Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) shall serve as the secretariat for the Committee. The PSWDO shall be responsible for the provision of technical and administrative support for the PCAT-VAWC and shall take charge

of the documentation of the proceedings of meetings, preparation of the reports and such other assistance as may be required by the Committee.

SECTION 7. Funding. The funding for the implementation of the programs and activities of the PCAT-VAWC shall be charged against the general fund of the PSWDO.

SECTION 8. Separability Clause. If any provision or part of this Executive Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the parts not affected hereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. Repealing Clause. Any executive orders rules and regulations, and/or a part thereof that is contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Order is hereby revoked or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
